Each PE exam lasts 8 hours and is split into a morning and an afternoon session. The PE exam is an open-book exam. You are allowed to bring reference materials to the exam.

The PE examination is an 8-hour test and is given twice a year at several locations in Texas (certain PE tests are given only once per year). The PE exam testing dates are scheduled for April and October. Individuals may register with NCEES to take the FE examination without submitting an application to the board.
