### Mailbox Rule for Contracts - The Business Professor

The mailbox rule is a doctrine in contract law which states that if mail is a reasonable method of conveyance for an acceptance, the acceptance becomes valid on the date that it is dropped in the mailbox and postmarked. By extension, this rule is also used for payments on insurance premiums, in which the payment is considered a form of acceptance of the contract, and some tax authorities also consider the postmarked date to be the acceptance date.

If an acceptance is mailed before a rejection, a valid contract is made. Because the acceptance is effective upon dispatch and the rejection is effective upon receipt, a contract is formed as soon as the acceptance is put in the mail. This is true even if the offeror receives the rejection first.
