What Is Squid Ink, and Should You Eat It?

You will be extracting squid ink from two sources- the main ink sac in the body, and small secondary deposits behind the eyes. First, pull the head and tentacles out of the body cavity. The guts will come along with the head: look for the small thin silvery sac about halfway along. Carefully detach the ink sac, taking care not to puncture it.

The ink consists mainly of melanin. However it can also contain dopamine, aspartic acid, and glutamic acid. For cooking purposes (e.g. Squid ink pasta) the ink is primarily used for food coloring and/or flavoring. The ink is extracted from the Squid's ink sacs, typically during the preparation process.

What's the Difference between Raw Squid Ink & Ink Used in ...

The ink gland and its associated ink sac empties into the rectum close to the anus, allowing the squid to rapidly discharge black ink into the mantle cavity and surrounding water. The ink is a suspension of melanin particles and quickly disperses to form a dark cloud that obscures the escape manoeuvres of the squid.

Sepia Ink There is one ink that is related to cephalopods: the historical artists' ink sepia, one of the brown inks used by artists for their pen and ink drawings. Sepia is a red-brown ink made from the ink sacs of cuttlefish, which are dried and ground to a fine powder, then mixed with shellac.

Thaw out the frozen Squid or Pusit and pull all the heads out and separate them from the bodies. Next, remove the clear plastic-looking thing inside the body (the "pen"). Then, carefully remove all the innards of the squid. Be patient in this part so that you don't tear up the body of the squid or end up skinning it.
