GUATEMALA CITIZENSHIP: Citizenship laws are based upon the Constitution of Guatemala. BY BIRTH: Child born within the territory of Guatemala, regardless of the nationality of the parents, including birth on any Guatemalan ship or aircraft. BY DESCENT: Child born abroad, at least one of whose parents is a citizen of Guatemala.

Guatemala recognizes de facto union, a similar concept to common law marriage, in Article 48 of its Political Constitution. Furthermore, the Constitution provides for the equal treatment of all children, regardless of the situation of their parents at the time of birth (Article 50). The registration of citizens, as well as the changes occurring by death, change of neighborhood, suspension, loss or restoration of citizenship, is checked at the time limits and with the modalities as determined by law. ARTICLE 57.-criminal action by the electoral crimes established by the law is public and prescribed in four years.

Dual citizenship had previously been banned in the United States, but in 1967 the US Supreme Court struck down most laws forbidding dual citizenship. However, the US government remained disdainful of dual citizenship for some time.
