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Guidelines For Competency Assessment As

Competency is the ability of personnel to apply their skill, knowledge, and experience to perform their laboratory duties correctly. Competency assessment is used to ensure that the laboratory personnel are fulfilling their duties as required by federal regulation. The following six (6) procedures are the minimal regulatory requirements for assessment of competency for all personnel performing laboratory testing: 1.

A Competency Assessment File (CAF) is used as a repository for information related to individual competence for all non-privileged healthcare personnel with patient contact and is a great way to keep track of training completed specific to their duty position. Maintaining CAFs for all healthcare individuals facilitates documentation of the training portion required in the Joint Regulation on Immunizations and Chemoprophylaxis for the Prevention of Infectious Diseases (AR 40-562, BUMEDINST 6230.
