The skin is composed of the epidermis and the dermis. The outermost surface of your skin (the superficial region) is made of a thick epithelial tissue called epidermis.The word "derm" means "skin".The prefix "epi-" means "above".Epidermal tissue is categorized as a keratinized stratified squamous epithelial tissue. Beneath the epidermis, (deep to the epidermis) is the layer of the dermis.
