An example of this is the algebra paradox: Suppose $a = b = 1$. Then $a^2 = ab$, so $a^2 - ab = 0$, so $a(a-b) = 0$. Now dividing both sides by $a-b$ shows that $a = 0$. But we assumed $a = 1$. (Resolution of this is left to the reader.) This book mostly focuses on the second kind, paradoxes that can be explained away with the right point of view.
