In some parts of the world, using plastic is already illegal. Kenya introduced one of the world's toughest laws against plastic bags in 2017. Now, Kenyans who are caught producing, selling, or even using plastic bags will risk imprisonment of up to four years or fines of \$40,000 (£31,000).
